

Information on the Processing of Personal Data

Tábořiště Lavičky, s.r.o., Company ID (IČ): 08282722, with its registered office at Bohostice č.p. 54, 262 31 Bohostice, acting as the personal data controller (hereinafter also the "Controller"), hereby informs you about the manner and scope of the processing of your personal data by the Controller in connection with the conclusion of a contract for accommodation and/or for the lease of land at Tábořiště Lavičky between you and the Controller (hereinafter the "Contract"), for the purpose of performing the contractual relationship, protecting the Controller's legitimate interests, and fulfilling the Controller's legal obligations.

PERFORMANCE OF THE CONTRACTUAL RELATIONSHIP AND THE CONTROLLER'S LEGITIMATE INTERESTS IN PERFORMING THE CONTRACTUAL RELATIONSHIP AND FULFILLING THE CONTROLLER'S LEGAL OBLIGATIONS

Legal basis and purpose of the processing of personal data: a) performance of the contractual relationship with the data subject, i.e. in particular negotiations on concluding the Contract or amending it and the mutual performance of rights and obligations under the Contract; b) protection of the Controller's legitimate interests, i.e. in particular securing and asserting the Controller's legal claims under the Contract; c) fulfilment of the Controller's legal obligations.

Categories of processed personal data: identification data (name, surname, residential address, date of birth, birth number and identity document number), contact data (telephone number, e-mail address) and the duration of the accommodation.

Method of processing personal data: personal data are processed manually, in both paper and electronic form.

Retention period of personal data: for the period necessary to secure the mutual rights and obligations arising from the Contract, i.e. always at least for the duration of the Contract and thereafter for the period during which the Controller is obliged/entitled to retain the personal data under binding legal regulations. In the case of accommodation, this is in particular a period of 6 years from the entry in the guest register (evidenční kniha) pursuant to the archiving obligation under Act No. 565/1990 Coll.; in the case of a land lease and other contracts, in particular until all obligations of the data subject towards the Controller have been settled, including any judicial enforcement of claims.

Processors, recipients and other entities to which personal data may be provided: Personal data may be provided to the campsite manager and to the Controller's accountants and attorneys. Upon request, or where necessary to protect the Controller's legitimate interests, personal data may be provided to public authorities (e.g. courts, bodies active in criminal proceedings, administrative authorities, etc.), to the extent necessary and within the limits of the law. Personal data will not be transferred by the Controller to third countries.

Contact form and communication: If you contact us via the web form or otherwise, we process the data you provide to us (in particular name, e-mail address, telephone number and address) solely for the purpose of customer communication and handling your enquiry, on the basis of the Controller's legitimate interest. This data is duly secured; we do not pass it on to third parties for their own purposes, nor do we use it for marketing purposes.

Camera system: The campsite premises are monitored by a camera system for the protection of property and the safety of persons, on the basis of the Controller's legitimate interest. By entering the monitored area, a visitor comes within the range of the cameras. Camera recordings are retained only for the strictly necessary period and used solely where needed to address a security incident; in such a case they may be provided to public authorities (e.g. the Police of the Czech Republic).

THE DATA SUBJECT HAS THE FOLLOWING RIGHTS TOWARDS THE CONTROLLER:

- the right to request from the Controller access to the personal data, their rectification in the event of inaccuracies, or their erasure where the purpose for which the personal data were processed has ceased, or where they were processed unlawfully,
- the right to restriction of processing and the right to object to the processing at any time free of charge,
- the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority, which is the Office for Personal Data Protection.
